Purpose/process

- A space which suits the people in it
- A location that works for people: access, mod, distance
- Room layout. Not a fixed committee formal layout. Ability to move tables.
- Wall space
- SIZE

- Suits people who like to work in a variety of different ways. (rigid/flexible, learning styles, how/what/why).
- People who
 1. Want to be there
 2. Know why they are there
 3. Are engaged
 4. Have a relationship with the topic/issue
- 'Know' where the participants are
- Some relationship before(?) workshop with individual delegates → already bought into the process
- Individuals are already engaged into objective and know what to expect from workshop in advance
- An organisation where people know something will change as a result.

- On purpose yet flexible
- Provide opportunity for everyone to contribute
- Knowing where we want to get to
- Ends well
